

Rules and Regulations for the award of Fellow of The Physiological Society of India

1. **Name of the fellowship:** Fellow of the Physiological Society of India (FPSI)
2. **Academic criteria:**
 - a) Ph.D. or equivalent (person having outstanding research/teaching contribution).
 - b) An individual held/holding a faculty position in the rank of Associate Professor/ scientist in an equivalent position and above in a reputed institute/scientist in a recognized institute who has been working in the field of physiology and allied sciences is eligible to apply for PSI Fellowship.
 - c) Scientific contribution: At least 8 publications in peer-reviewed journals (pub-med, OJS/PKP or other internationally accepted) and 2 papers in PSI journals or books or chapters (pub-med/ OJS/PKP or other standard publication) [A copy must be submitted].
 - d) ONE HARD copies (spiral binding) along with the soft copy (in pdf format) of the nomination form, duly completed and with all information filled in as required, are to be submitted to the Head Office of PSI, Kolkata.

3. **Procedural criteria:**
 - a) Life membership: Must be a Life Member of PSI
 - b) Processing/ Nomination Fee: Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousands only) (non-refundable)
 - c) Nomination Pro-forma will be available from Hony. General Secretary, at the outset, subsequently from the website.
 - d) The nomination will be done by two PSI Fellows (FPSI). Each FPSI may nominate two persons per year.
 - e) Nominations made for the fellowship title shall remain in good standing for a period of **3 years** and who are not selected for the period of time, may be renominated after a gap of 2 years (Nominee should update CV every year).

Experts for the technical committee: Five Experts (to be selected by EC members) and the President of PSI along with Hony. General Secretary of PSI will have voting rights for the selection of fellows for PSI.

Time for Nomination: The nomination form for the fellowship will be available in the Society website and the completed nomination must be reached to the Office of The PSI by **31st March of each year.**

Total fellows: Maximum **6 (six) per year.**
